Red State Access Project - Provides free, safe abortion medication to those who need it in states that restrict or fully criminalize abortion. Ben Atherton-Zeman, Liaison

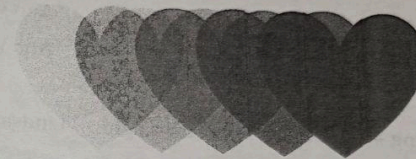
